- e. The Undergraduate Academic Program Review Committee (PRC) shall consist of eight faculty members (two from Liberal Arts, two from of Science and Technology, two from Social Science and Professional Studies and two from the School of Business) appointed by the Provost and the Director of Assessment and Evaluation (ex officio, non-voting). The committee:
- 1) reports to the Provost;
 - 2) recommends criteria to be used in the program review process;
 - 3) conducts a continuing study and systematic review of all program offerings of the University;
 - 4) makes recommendations to the Provost on program continuation/discontinuation, program related resource (re)allocation, and curricular modification.
